## **Terms and Conditions**

### **The Columbarium at St. George's Episcopal Church**

The following are the terms and conditions of the agreement between the Subscriber, whose name appears on this document, and St. George's Episcopal Church in New Orleans, LA.

1. Subscriber does not acquire any title or right of ownership or tenancy in St. George's Episcopal Church Columbarium. The Columbarium and the spaces and memorial markers, their use and maintenance, are at all times subject to management and control by St. George's.
2. Internment in the Columbarium shall be limited to parish members who make the donation indicated on this document and who are current or former regular attendees and contributors of record of St. George's Episcopal Church, or their designees, subject to exceptions as St. George's Episcopal Church may from time to time approve. Any substitution of the person or persons designated on this document must be approved by St. George's Episcopal Church and annexed in writing to this agreement.
3. The size, shape, type, material and placement of each and every memorial marker or plaque shall be subject to the requirements of St. George's Episcopal Church, as may be revised and changed from time to time. Inscriptions shall be limited to the name, date of birth and date of death of the person buried in the niche. The character of the legend and the type and size if the lettering shall also be subject to the requirements issued by St. George's Episcopal Church.
4. St. George's clergy will officiate at the internment service. Assisting clergy are subject to the approval of the Rector or Priest-in-charge at St. George's Episcopal Church and in accordance with such arrangements as they may require.
5. St. George's Episcopal Church will endeavor to exercise thorough and reasonable care in maintaining and improving the Columbarium for as long as St. George's Episcopal Church shall exist as a place of worship or a legal religious corporation. However, St. George's Episcopal Church assumes no liability for destruction or damage to the Columbarium, the ashes inurned therein, or the urns or memorial markers for any reason.
6. St. George's Episcopal Church will charge a fee in accordance with the then current Columbarium Schedule of Charges.
7. Subscriber binds his/her estate, devisees, and assigns to fulfilling the obligation and exercising the privileges of this agreement.
